## Work, Grow, Explore: Rural Tasmania.

Join the Rural General Practice Settlement Incentive (RGPSI) program and receive up to \$100,000 over 5 years working in beautiful Tasmania.

Tasmania like most regional areas in Australia is experiencing challenges in attracting and retaining the health workforce required to support its health system. The Tasmanian Government is focused on creating and sustaining a health professional workforce that provides accessible and effective care for all Tasmanians.

Aligning with the *Long-Term Plan for Healthcare in Tasmania 2040*, the RGPSI grant program was announced by the Tasmanian Government in November 2024. This initiative aims to attract up to 40 new GPs to rural and regional Tasmania by providing incentives of up to \$100,000 over 5 years for GPs who choose to settle in prioritised rural and regional locations.

Offered by The People Project Tasmania on behalf of the Tasmanian Department of Health, the RGPSI is open to Vocationally Registered GPs taking up positions in MMM 3-7 areas, particularly in general practices connected to District Hospitals and Multipurpose Centres, in addition to the New Norfolk District Hospital Services in MMM 2. There are three priority areas, 1, 2 and 3, and set criteria for each group.

## Eligibility:

- Registered with AHPRA as a qualified General Practitioner.
- Willing to provide services in an eligible regional area of Tasmania.
- Have (or are willing to obtain) provider numbers for the new location.
- Have (or are willing to obtain) credentials in regional hospitals or multi-purpose centres.
- Successful applicants will be required to work at least 0.5 FTE for 47 weeks each year in the approved location to remain eligible.
